SIMPLE PAST

Last night I played tennis with my brother. he/she played you/we/they played

PAST PROGRESSIVE

I was playing tennis when I fell over and grazed my knee. he/she was playing you/we/they were playing

PAST PERFECT

I had played tennis in the morning before lunch. he/she had played you/we/they had played

PRESENT TENSE

SIMPLE PRESENT 🚺

I play tennis with my brother most weekends. he/she plays you/we/they play

PRESENT PROGRESSIVE

I am playing tennis with my brother right now. he/she is playing you/we/they are playing

PRESENT PERFECT 🜔

I have played tennis with my brother since I was four. he/she has played you/we/they have played
