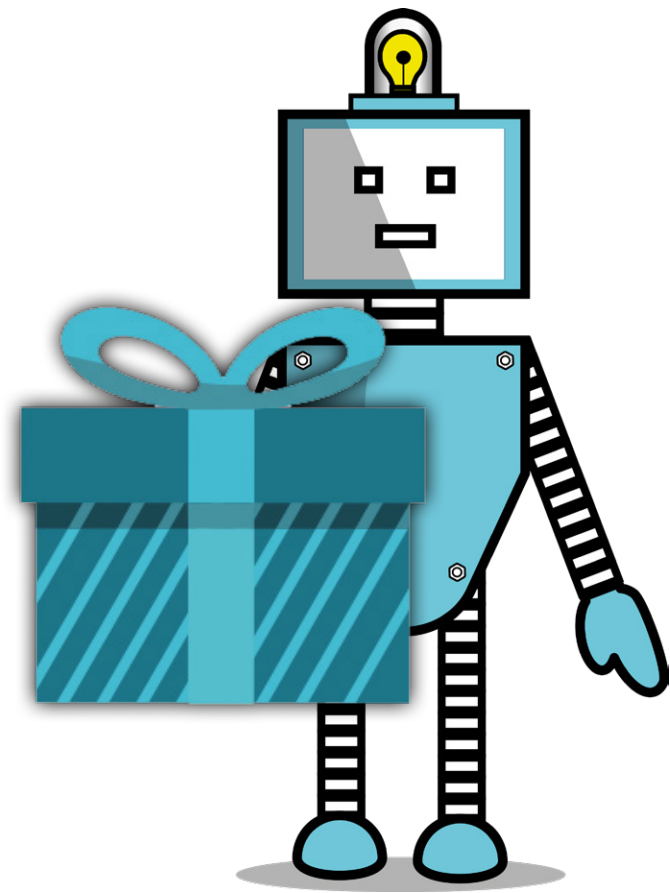

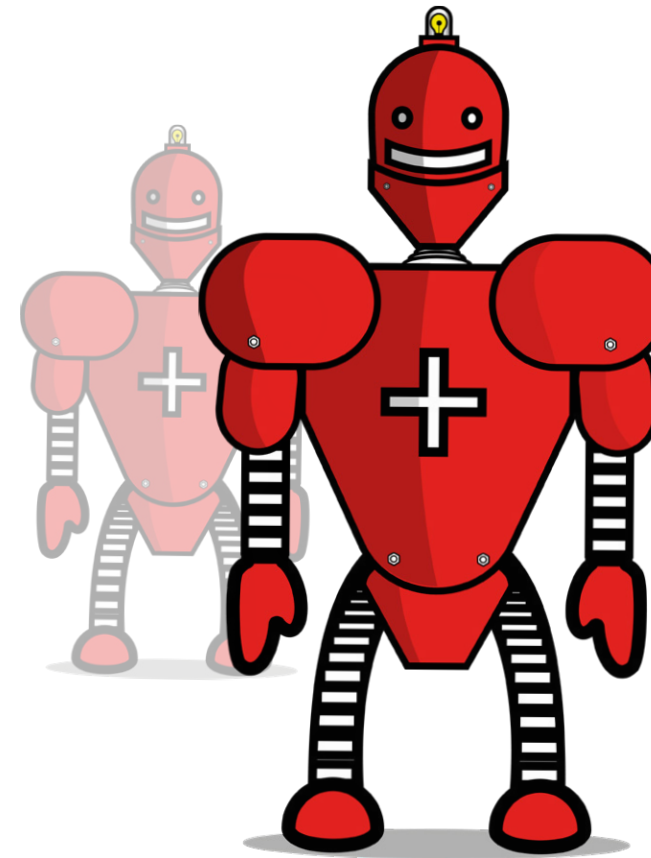

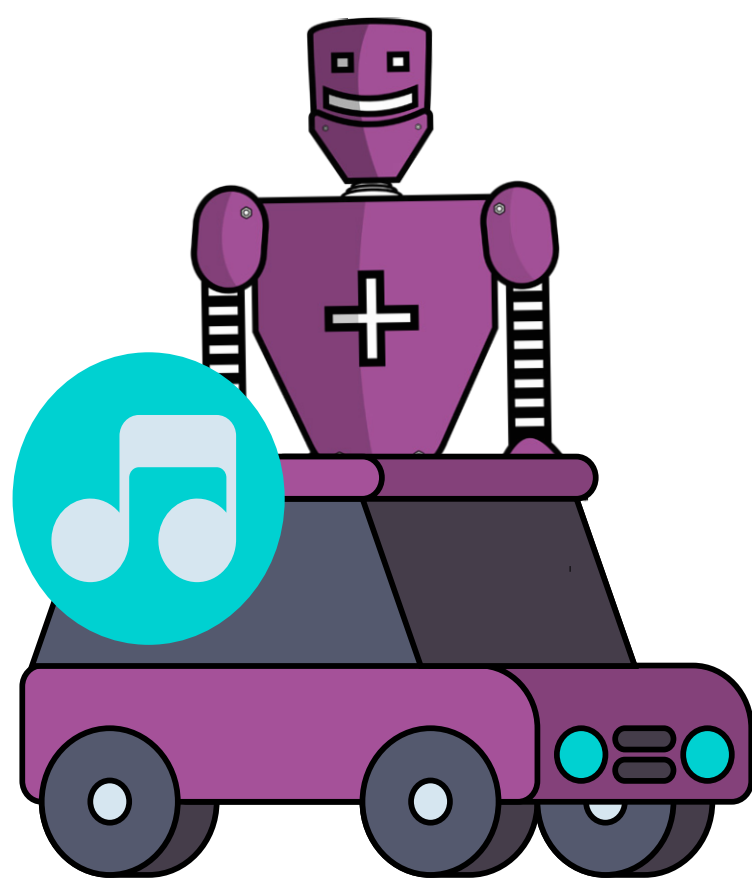


Which words in the following sentence are adjectives?

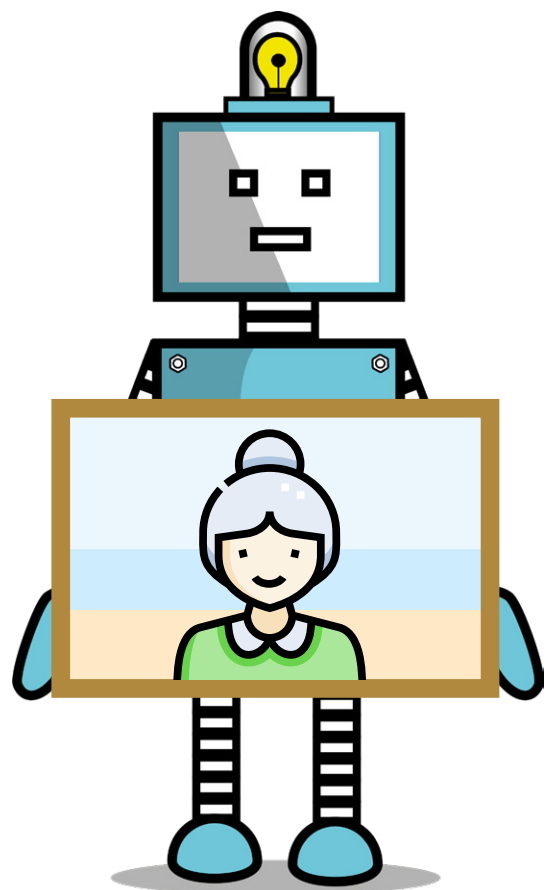

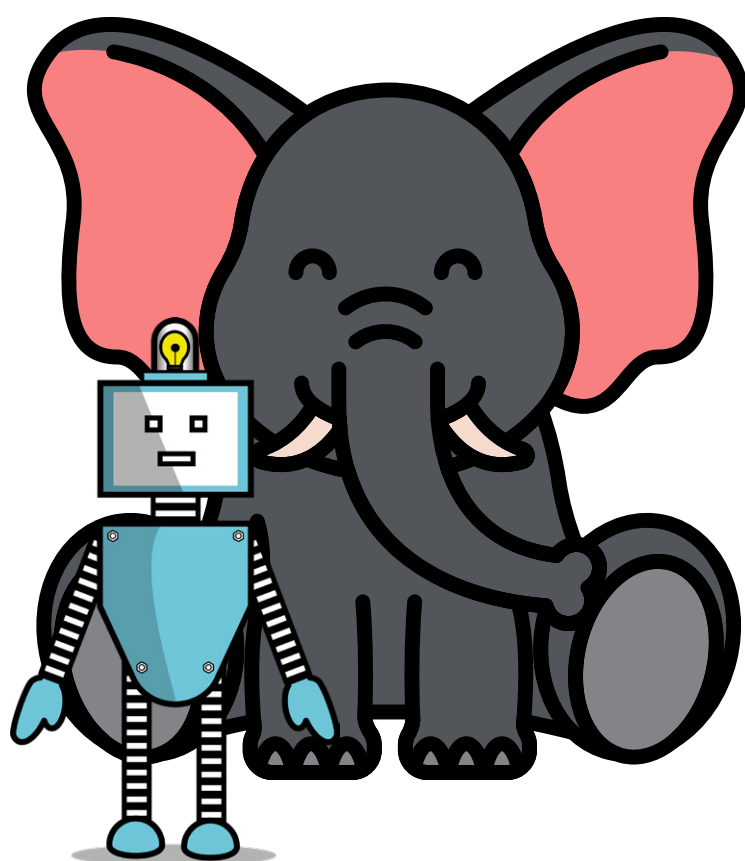
