## **Pathetic Fallacy**

Writers describe the weather or the setting to reveal information about a character, such as how they are feeling, or to create a certain mood or atmosphere.

Sunny weather may reflect that a character is feeling happy.

Stormy weather may symbolise that a character is feeling angry.

Fog can symbolise confusion or ignorance.

Rainy weather may reflect that a character is feeling sad.

Snow can symbolise peace, or winter can symbolise death.
