

CENTURY + COBIS Learning Legends Terms and Conditions

- 1. To enter the CENTURY + COBIS Learning Legends (the 'Competition') your school must be a COBIS member or applicant school. There are a limited number of places available to non-member schools by invitation only.
- 2. To participate in the Competition, you must have access to the CENTURY platform with accounts set up for all participating staff and students.
- 3. CENTURY Tech will offer full and unrestricted access to the platform to all participating schools for the duration of the Competition.
- 4. The Competition will start at 00:00 GMT on Monday 10th March 2025 and end at 23:59 GMT on Thursday 20th March 2025.
- 5. The last chance to enter the Competition will be 23:59 GMT on Monday 3rd March 2025.
- 6. Participation is open to students in Years 3-11 at schools with a registered COBIS account. Each school may participate in only one of the following categories:
 - **Primary School:** For entries featuring only primary school students
 - Secondary School: For entries featuring only secondary school students
 - All-Through School: For entries featuring both primary and secondary school students
- 7. School Leaderboard Scoring System to ensure fair and engaging competition, the following scoring system will be used:
 - Leaderboard Eligibility: Schools must have a minimum of 50 onboarded students to be eligible for inclusion on the leaderboard.









Individual Student Scores:

- Students earn points for each question they answer correctly in a nugget.
- Students can retry nuggets to improve their score. Only correct answers within the first 3 attempts will count towards the school's overall score. This is to avoid excessive repetition of questions in easy nuggets. We suggest highlighting this rule to your students.
- We will also provide data on the average number of all questions answered per active student as well as the total number of nuggets completed and overall study time.

School Overall Score:

- For a school's overall score to qualify for the leaderboard, 25% of the school's total active students must be active in all competition courses: English, maths, and science including the BBC Bitesize Learning Collection.
- Winning: To maximise your school's chances of winning, encourage consistent student participation and high usage across all competition courses (English, maths, science, and the BBC Bitesize Learning Collection). The winning school will be determined based on the highest overall score, reflecting strong engagement across all subject areas.

Clarifications:

- o Active Student, is defined as a student who has logged in and completed at least one nugget on the platform during the competition period.
- Onboarded Students, refers to the total amount of student accounts.







- 8. Calculation of School Scores the overall score for each school will be calculated as follows:
 - The percentage of active students in a given subject is calculated by dividing the number of active students in that subject by the total number of active students in all competition subjects at that school.
 - This percentage is then used as a weighting factor for the subject.
 - The subject score is determined by multiplying the total number of questions answered correctly per student in that subject by the weighting factor.
 - Minimum Participation Requirement: To be included in the school's total score, a minimum of 25% of the school's total active students must be active in each subject (English, maths, science, including the BBC Bitesize Learning Collection), and a minimum of 10% of the school's total enrolled students must be active in any. If the active student percentage for a subject falls below 25%, the school's total active students falls below 10%, or the school has fewer than 50 students onboarded, the score for that subject will be excluded from the total.
 - **Total Score Aggregation:** The total score for each school will be the sum of the individual subject scores that meet the minimum participation requirement.
- 9. Nugget Frenzy In addition to the school-level competition, we will also be running "Nugget Frenzy," a separate initiative to recognize individual students who demonstrate exceptional engagement on the platform during the competition period.
 - Eligibility: Nugget Frenzy is open to all students, regardless of whether their school meets the 50-student minimum requirement for the main competition.
 - Recognition: Students who achieve outstanding levels of engagement and participation in Nugget Frenzy will be awarded certificates to acknowledge their efforts. Further details on the criteria for recognition and prize distribution will be announced soon.
 - Participation Criteria: To be considered for Nugget Frenzy recognition, students must complete at least one nugget in each of the competition







subjects (English, maths, science, and the BBC Bitesize Learning Collection). As in the main competition, students are allowed a maximum of 3 attempts per nugget.

10. Competition Prizes and Winners

- Minimum Participation: The Competition will only run if a minimum of 15 schools participate.
- Winning Schools: The top-placed school in each category (Primary, Secondary and All-Through) at 23:59 GMT on 20th March 2025 will win a £250 Amazon voucher.
- School's Leaderboard and Announcement: The top 5 schools on each category leaderboard at 23:59 GMT on 20th March 2025, including the category winners, will be announced on Friday 21st March 2025.
- Prize Delivery: Prizes will be forwarded to winning schools within 2 weeks of the competition's completion (actual delivery times may vary depending on location).
- Nugget Frenzy Individual Student Recognition: Schools will be contacted to let them know if any of their students have been recognised for exceptional usage during the competition. Certificates will be sent within 2 weeks of the competition's completion.
- 11. As a business based in the UK, CENTURY Tech is following the UK government policy of services exports ban to Russia. Therefore, presently we are unable to offer schools based in Russia access to the CENTURY + COBIS Learning Legends Competition.
- **12.** Only bona fide schools are eligible to compete in the Competition.
- 13. Home schools or non-school organisations are not eligible. Each school with a registered COBIS account should participate as an individual school.
- 14. Only bona fide students are eligible to participate in the Competition. Schools with anything more than experimental use from academic staff accounts during the Term of the Challenge may be excluded from the Competition.







- 15. Any foul play, cheating, or attempted manipulation of the results will result in a permanent exclusion of the offending school from the Competition. CENTURY Tech's judgement on this point will be final.
- 16. The winning school will be announced by Friday 21st March 2025. The winners will be notified by email and on social media.
- 17. By entering the Competition the winner agrees to participate in such reasonable promotional activity and material as CENTURY Tech and COBIS may require.
- 18. This competition will be operated by CENTURY Tech Limited, registered address: 2 Printer's Yard, 90a The Broadway, London SW19 1RD.
- 19. Registration data will be collected by CENTURY Tech and shared with COBIS for the administration and delivery of the Competition. COBIS and CENTURY Tech have a data-sharing agreement in place to protect the transfer of this information. This information will not be passed by COBIS or CENTURY to any other parties.
