



What is CENTURY?


CENTURY is a tool to help you improve your Maths and English.

You can use CENTURY on a computer, laptop, tablet or smartphone.







- If you are unsure of the answer, press the 'I don't know button'





If you are stuck on a question, you can go back to the video or slideshow at any time.



Introduction to Ratio

Remember
Ratio is the measure of the relative size of two measurements, expressed as a proportion

Example: Find the ratio of blue balls to green balls.


Since there are 3 blue balls and 4 green balls we may write this as a ratio of: 3 : 4

Since we were asked to find blue to green, we must write the ratio in this order

This means there are 3 blue balls for every 4 green balls

You can track your progress in your assigned courses, as well as view your strengths and areas for improvement.


